In recent years, the Commission on Cancer has put more emphasis on utilizing the National Cancer Data Base (NCDB) data quality tools (CP³R, RQRS, CQIP, as well as Completeness, Benchmark and Survival reports) to evaluate, interpret and report on the program's performance.

- Conducts audits aimed to improve CP³R, Completeness and NCDB reports.
