



WHAT ARE MY HEALTH INSURANCE OPTIONS IN OHIO?

You may qualify if you're a U.S. citizen or legal permanent resident for five years who is...

MEDICAID

Age 19-64 and not on Medicare.
Children up to 18, pregnant women and Medicare enrollees may also be eligible under different income rules.

Family of 1 – under \$1,353/month
Family of 4 – under \$2,788/month

Doctor visits, hospital services, medication, free health screenings, mental health/substance abuse treatment, dental, vision and more.

Nothing; it's free.

MARKETPLACE

Not on Medicare or Medicaid.

Non-citizens who are lawfully present may also qualify.

**Private insurance may also be purchased directly through plans or insurance agents/brokers.*

Financial help is available for:
Family of 1 – under \$3,923/month
Family of 4 – under \$8,083/month

Doctor visits, hospital services, medication, free health screenings, mental health/substance abuse treatment and more.

The average discount is 67% off base price.
85% of Ohioans eligible for financial help.

MEDICARE

Eligible for Social Security or railroad retirement benefits. You must be at least 65, have received Social Security Disability for two years or have end-stage kidney disease.

Financial help is available for:
Family of 1 – under \$1,471/month
Family of 2 – under \$1,991/month

Part A: Hospital and nursing home care
Part B: Office visits, screenings, supplies
Part D: Medication

Part A: Free for most.
Part B: \$104/month
Part D: \$33/month on average
Financial help is available.

Part A & B: 01/01 – 3/31
Part D or Advantage Plan: 10/15 – 12/7
