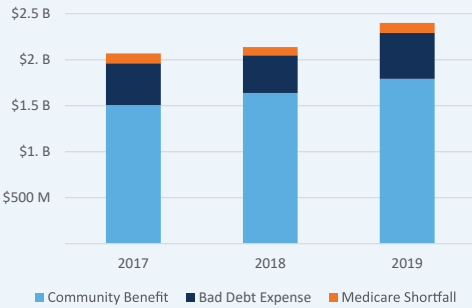
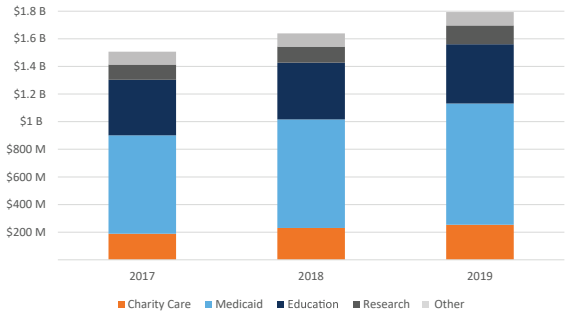
Programs and activities that provide treatment or promote health and healing as a response to community needs.

2019 Northeast Ohio Hospital Community Benefit: **\$1.794 billion**



2019 Community Benefit + Medicare Shortfall + Bad Debt = **\$2.402 billion**

Medicare shortfall and bad debt are additional ways hospitals contribute to their communities through subsidization of care.

TOTAL UNCOMPENSATED CARE

2019 Charity Care + Bad Debt = **\$750.6 million**

All reported cost data is net of any offsetting revenues.



2019 COMMUNITY BUILDING = \$1M

Not considered hospital community benefit by the Internal Revenue Service, community building includes activities such as improving housing, economic development, community health improvement advocacy, leadership development for community members, and other types of community support.
